Foundation Year

An overview

Overview



Our Foundation Year is a **free** and **fully funded** multi-disciplinary course in the Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences, for those that have **experienced educational disadvantage** or **disruption**.

Eligibility

Applicants must meet our eligibility requirements. There are three categories, and **you must meet one or more criteria from at least two categories** (unless you are care-experienced which makes you automatically eligible). Examples include:



Individual

- You have been a young carer whilst in education
- You experienced health issues that resulted in long absences
- You became homeless whilst in education



Family

- You are or have been eligible for Free School Meals
- You have a combined household income of £25,000 or less
- You or your parents/ carers are eligible for Universal Credit



School/college

- Your school/college performed poorly in a school inspection
- A school/college you have attended has below-average attainment
- A school/college you have attended sends few people to Higher Education
